Dear Friends

In the interests of full disclosure let it be known that I have played the Easter Bunny. One Sunday morning back in the 1980s I donned a pair of rabbit ears and chomped on a carrot while being interviewed in church as the most famous of hares. I also remember a worship service in the 1990s when one of our members walked out of worship and returned ten minutes later and yelled out, "I just returned from seeing the Easter Bunny!" "What's up Doc" indeed. The fuzzy one has never achieved the status of Santa, just as Easter has never become as significant a cultural holiday as Christmas. That's just fine with me.


While the fact that we happen to reside in the Northern Hemisphere means that Easter always coincides with the coming of spring, from our Christian perspective Easter is truly the day for all seasons. When we praise Jesus and pray to Jesus we affirm that Jesus is alive and kicking. When we say "Dear Jesus help me!" and "Please Jesus show me how I can help them" we appeal to a living reality not a distant memory. The resurrection of Jesus is truly the central event of all human history Personal encounter with the risen Christ is the ongoing relationship which changes the course of our lives. God is not a remote divinity hiding behind a cloud. God, in Jesus , is nearer to us than we ever dreamed.

Every Easter morning since I have been a pastor I have chosen to begin worship with the hymn, "Christ the Lord is Risen Today" While far from a fully mature Christian, I have met Him, trust Him and experience surprising reaffirmations of His presence each day. How will others encounter this greatest expression of love? In part, through us. We live in a time when many hold the church at arms length if not in contempt because of the hypocrisy and unkindness of Christians, clergy and laity alike. Let us be different. May others truly see Jesus in us and know that He is risen indeed.

I look forward to seeing you for communion worship at 7 PM on Holy Thursday April 18 and Easter morning April 21. No rabbits are expected.
