Message from Rev. Dr. Carl Heick

Dear Friends

I love to ask questions. It is my preferred way of socializing. In part because I am an introvert, I prefer to let other people do the talking while I listen. Believe it or not, I would rather listen to a sermon than deliver one. However, they say I have to give them. Asking people how they met their significant other or what they like to do for fun is a great way to connect with others while learning a great deal about them. If the cat has your tongue try asking a simple and polite question and see where it leads. You might learn something unexpected or even make a new friend.

While I suspect, but am not sure, that Jesus was more on the extroverted side, I know that He also delighted in asking questions. His questions were no idle chitchat but got right to the heart of significant matters. Here are a few of Jesus's best questions:

"Who do you say that I am?" Jesus stands at the center of history. He is not just interested in revealing Himself as Savior tor Messiah, but seeks to know what our personal and communal connection to Him is all about. He is not a doctrine but a person and He wants us to know Him.

"Why are you so afraid?" Jesus recognizes our fears before we know them ourselves, our fears of illness, loneliness, rejection, unemployment, harm to our loved ones, natural disaster, abuse, depression, and death. While this is a partial list, Jesus knows the full list and He is there in the midst of the storm.

"Do you want to get well?" Jesus asked this to an infirm man who had come to the same public place to beg for years. The question comes to all of us who stay stuck in various unhealthy patterns which become familiar and comfortable in spite of the toll they take. Do we truly want things to change when change may require us to function differently?

"Who touched me?" Jesus sensed that a sick woman had reached out to Him in a crowd. Perhaps He knew who it was all along but wanted to connect more deeply with the one who reached out her hand. Jesus knows when we cry out to Him. He senses our "touch." This woman was made well. In this sense, He also touched her.

Jesus asked many more questions, many of which brought his listeners into deeper connection with Him. Asking good questions can build relationships. Learning to listen more and speak less will draw others in.

Ask me a question sometime. You might get an introvert to talk.
