# Baptist By-Line

APRIL 2020

Message shared by Pastor Carl Heick

Dear friends,

As told in the Gospel of John, before Jesus enters Jerusalem to face the darkest hours of His journey He is called to the grave of Lazarus, His friend and the brother of Mary and Martha. Lazarus had lain in the tomb for four days. When Jesus observes the mourners, especially sisters Mary and Martha, and the depth of their grief, He is deeply moved. This is the context for the shortest verse in the Bible, "Jesus wept." What a witness to the humanity of Jesus. He too feels the deep need for human connection which God has woven into us. Do you remember the end of this story? Jesus calls Lazarus forth from the tomb and he emerges with the stink of death and grave still on him. This is not a resurrection to a fully changed and renewed body, but rather a temporary return to earthly life. It is however the occasion for Jesus to affirm "I am the resurrection and the life..." Easter is coming and coming soon.

You and I are keenly feeling the loss of human connection during this time of social distancing. We long for the joy of an Easter together with others. We wonder when the anxiety and suffering will end. There is no easy answer to those questions. Jesus never explained suffering. He came into the world to live it and face it. He promises to face it with us and never to abandon us. When Jesus rises on Easter morning His human suffering is done but His divine compassion for our sufferings is fully alive.

I am gratified to not have heard of any virus related illness in our congregation. I hope it stays that way. It is still not clear when we will be able to gather together again. In the meantime do those things which are required or recommended to stay healthy. Keep your distance but find other ways to be close. Wash your hands (mine have never been so clean) and let them lead you into prayer. Stay informed but don't watch news all day. Facebook is not a good primary source for news. Listen to the experts in the health care field. Hunches and suspicions don't mean anything. There is an old phrase which was shared with me a long time ago and I stand by it. "All good science is God's science." God has entrusted us with genuine scientific wisdom for our good and God's glory. Pray that our medical experts will learn quickly and do everything they can the enhance the fight against COVID-19. Give thanks and pray for the courageous doctors and nurses who are on the front lines.

Jesus still weeps, for our sufferings and for our lack of trust. Your love and generosity to your family, your church family and your neighbors far and wide means the world. Your trust in Jesus means even more. Jesus has not left us. See you as soon as wise and possible.
